



## Guidelines for authors of accepted abstracts

**Abstracts will be published online on the conference website and in the book of abstracts** that will be available to the conference participants in hard copies at the conference venue. Considering that your abstract will be formally published, before publication (online and printed) you still have the possibility to edit it on the conference submission system **until the end of December** (by clicking “Your contributions”/“Edit contribution details”).

**All accepted contributions will be presented during the conference as posters.** Poster sessions will be embedded in thematic workshops during the conference. Please **use the standard format** provided on the conference website (<http://3sc.unccd.int/participants/submit-an-abstract>) to design your poster, and bring your printed poster with you at the conference. Posters should be 70 cm x 100 cm in size, with portrait orientation and contain the following information:

- Logo, title, date and place of the conference as displayed on the template
- Title of the contribution
- Authors, affiliations and contacts
- Rationale
- Methods used and partnership set up
- Results
- Outcomes
- Acknowledgements, if any
- Illustrations (table, graph, photo, etc.) with legends
- References

Your posters will also be posted on the conference website. Please upload your poster in pdf format (max. 10 Mb) on the conference submission system (<https://www.conftool.pro/3sc-unccd-2015>) **before the end of February** (by clicking “Your submissions”/“Final upload”). On this screen, you will also have to sign electronically the copyright agreement. Please note that the collection of abstracts and related posters will be available online in a browsable format and will constitute the conference proceedings.

*Please note that attending the conference is free of charge, but the organizers do not cover travel and accommodation expenses for the participants.*
